Qualifications, Knowledge, Experience and Skills Required for Potential Tutor Training Delegates

BECOMING A SPORTS LEADERS UK TUTOR - What qualifications should a prospective tutor have?

Tutors should hold the following qualifications or similar to the following:

- A DCSF recognised Physical Education qualification
- A National Governing Body of Sport Coaching qualification
- A Home Office armed/public service qualification in Sport or Physical Education
- A Sports Development qualification
- A youth and Community degree/diploma
- A recognised dance qualification

The common tutoring skills involved in the above qualifications are:

- A variety of presentation skills including verbal, written, use of IT and practical delivery skills
- A variety of group leading skills, both on a 'one to one' basis and on a 'one to many' basis
- Engaging learning styles with individuals or with groups, that lead to behaviour change
- Skills to motivate, encourage and develop the participants ability to become more independent
- Skills to guide, direct and support individuals towards new solutions and experiences

The above qualifications are usually associated with a set of experiences which we would expect our tutors to have obtained:

- Experience of working with children and adults in a variety of settings, including games, play, sport and youth and community settings
- Experience of directing individuals or groups towards behaviour change: whether in sport, dance, PE or PSHE, crime diversion, lifestyle choices
- Experience of assessing and evaluating performance / progress
- Experience of using different teaching methods to engage individuals with different learning styles and different abilities
