

# PARTICIPANTS CODE OF CONDUCT

The event will be run with the following principles of participation in mind. **The Group Managers should ensure that all of their participants are aware of these principles and have agreed to abide by the Code of Conduct below.**

An environment that allows bullying, shouting, racism or sexism is **not acceptable**.

Principles of Participation	Code of Conduct for Participants
<b>Fair Play</b>	Treat others with the same respect and fairness that you would like them to show you. Demonstrate 'Fair Play' when participating
<b>Equity</b>	Respect differences in gender, disability, culture, race, age, sexual orientation and religious belief etc between yourself and others. Challenge discrimination and prejudice. Value and learn from the diversity of the people you meet and show patience with others and act with dignity at all times.
<b>Responsibilities</b>	Look out for yourself and the welfare of others. Do not engage in any irresponsible or illegal behaviour. Challenge behaviour that falls below the expected standards of the event. Speak out if you are concerned about anything or if you feel uncomfortable about your own needs and those of others. Be organised and on time.
<b>Friendship</b>	Take time to thank those who help you to take part, whether that is your family, an organisation or your team mates.
